Alan Benjamin Wright, 69, husband of the late Veena (Decha) Wright, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, August 3, 2019 at St. Francis Hospital – Eastside.

Born in West Point, GA, he was the son of Louise (Lifsey) Wright and the late Cecil Dalton Wright. Alan was a U.S. Air Force Veteran of the Vietnam War and graduate of Greenville Technical College. 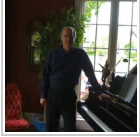
