



Albert Wright Tyson

May 12, 1928 - September 14, 2022

Albert "Al" Wright Tyson, 94, of Greenville, passed away on September 15th, 2022, surrounded by his loving wife and family.

Born in Lebanon, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Albert Wright Tyson, Sr. and Marion Isabella Keefer Tyson. He retired as a fuel system specialist with Delta Air Lines in Atlanta and was a member of Trinity Presbyterian Church.

He is survived by his wife of 71 years: Patricia Hudson Tyson; daughters: Gale (Chuck) Cutler and Laura (Chebli) Mounzer; grandchildren: Zachary and Eric Cutler and Anthony and Patricia Mounzer; great-grandchild Emmett Cutler, sister: Joan Tyson Colborn and niece and nephews James, Mark, Cathryn and Jonathan Colborn.

Al grew up in Pennsylvania, attended Hershey High School and Junior College, and served in the U.S. Army/Air Corps as a Sergeant during the Korean War. He was stationed at Donaldson Air Force Base in Greenville in November of 1950 when he met his future wife, the then Patricia Hudson.

Al was an athlete who loved swimming competitively, starting in high school and continuing through his 70's in various team and individual competitions. He also enjoyed competing in the S.C. Senior Olympics after retiring to

Greenville, coming home with medals from various sports in addition to his swimming victories. He took great pleasure in singing as part of the church choir wherever he lived, often as a soloist; and for a time participated as a member of the Choral Guild of Atlanta and the Delta Air Lines chorus. He was also active as a member, deacon and elder in the Trinity Presbyterian Church.

A receiving of friends will be held on Sunday afternoon, 1:00 p.m. until 2:00 p.m. at Trinity Presbyterian Church followed by the funeral service at 2:00 p.m. in the church. Burial will follow in Coleman Memorial Cemetery. After the burial, a gathering of friends for refreshments will take place in the Trinity Presbyterian gymnasium.
