Anthony Aylor “Sonny” Padgett, 74, of Easley, Widower of the late Nancey Jeraldine Moore Padgett, passed away peacefully at his home with his daughter and two grandsons by his side, Tuesday, December 22, 2020. Born in Rocky Mount, NC, he was the son of the late Aylor Aron and Darlene Elizabeth Williams Padgett. Mr. Padgett served in the US Marine Corps during the Vietnam conflict, and was a Purple Heart recipient. 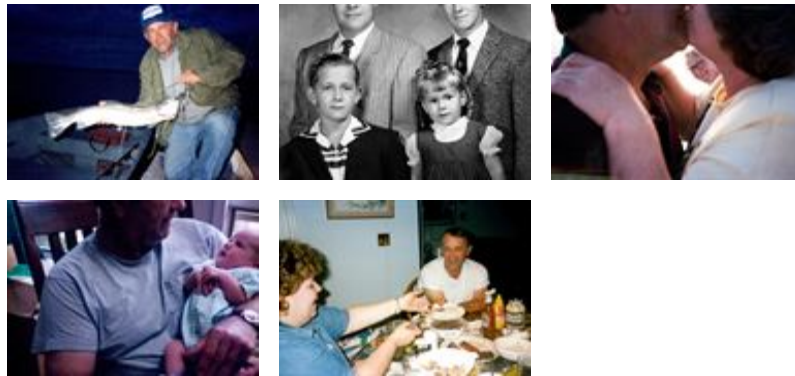

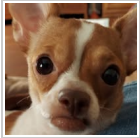

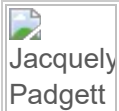
