Arthur Ervin "Junior" Cox, Jr., 92, went to be with the Lord on Friday, August 3, 2018 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Born in Greenville, SC (Judson Community), he was the son of the late Arthur Ervin Cox, Sr. and Eliza McGaha Cox. Junior was a US Army Veteran of WWII, retired owner of Junior Cox Supermarket in Cleveland, SC and a dedicated Farmer most of his life. He was a member of Cleveland First Baptist Church where he taught the Friendship Sunday School Class for over 50 years and was past Chairman of the Deacon Board.

Surviving is a son: Larry Cox (Judy); daughters: Debbie Barbare (Randy) and Tracey Simpson; 6 grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren and a niece, Sandra Childress (Jack).

Along with his parents, Junior was predeceased by his wife of 61 years, Mary Richmond Cox in April of 2014 and a sister, Sarah Cox Singleton.

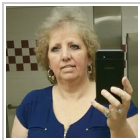

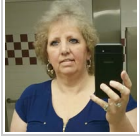
