



Dr. Arthur Kreft

January 4, 1935 - May 31, 2016

Dr. Arthur E. Kreft, 81, of Greer, went home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Tuesday in Virginia at Roanoke Memorial Hospital.

Born in Chicago, IL, he was the son of the late Paul Henry Carl and Florence Elizabeth Hurd Kreft. Dr. Kreft attended and graduated from Toccoa Falls High School, Tennessee Temple University, University of Florida, and Luther Rice Seminary. He was a retired Christian school teacher, preacher, an accomplished artist, and was a member of Choice Hills Baptist Church.
