Barbee Leonard Corbin, 78, of Travelers Rest, passed away at his home on Friday, July 1, 2016.

Born in Asheville NC, he was a son of the late Thomas Leonard and Bida Marie Elliott Corbin. Mr. Corbin was a US Army veteran having served during the Cuban Missile Crisis; he was the retired Southeastern Manager of The Wood Group Turbines with offices in Atlanta and Greenville and was a faithful member of Clearview Baptist Church.

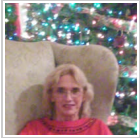

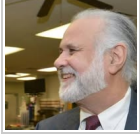
