Benny Blackstone, 73, of Greenville, passed away Friday, May 27, 2016.

Born in Greenville County, he was a son of the late Green Taylor and Cora Mae Noe Blackstone. Mr. Blackstone was the owner of Blackstone's Garage, where he started working with his father at age eleven. He was a faithful member and served as a Deacon at Calvary First Baptist Church in Greenville.

Surviving are his wife of fifty-two years, Barbara Wood Blackstone; two daughters: Angie Foster (Terry), and Kim Roberts (Chris); two brothers: Tommy Blackstone, and Jack Blackstone (Sherry); one sister: Nancy Blackstone; and three grandchildren: McKensie Lackey, Corbyn Foster, and Elizabeth Roberts.
