Betty Lee Wilson Hightower is now present in the presence of the King. She left us on August 19, 2022, to be reunited with her late husband William Randolph Hightower.

Affectionally known to her family as “Ma”, she was born in Easley, SC on March 24, 1929, to Hovey Lee and Juanita Allison Wilson. She grew up in the George’s Creek community of Easley and graduated from Berea High School, where she played varsity basketball and was a star guard for the team. A lifelong Baptist, she taught the children of George’s Creek Baptist Church for almost 40 years in Sunday School and the children’s church. Currently she is a member of Earle Street Baptist Church.
