March 10, 1928 - December 19, 2015

Betty Page Ninan, 86, passed into the arms of her Savior on Saturday, December 19, 2015.

Born on March 10, 1929 in Middlesboro, KY, she was the daughter of the late Jeremiah Hilton and Estelle Mae Brooks.

She was a long-time resident of Greenville, SC and worked at Furman University Bookstore for many years until retiring in 1991 . She later moved to Suffolk, VA.
