



## Betty Dalton Tindle Knight

Betty Joe (Dalton) Tindle Knight, 94, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday morning, February 2, 2022, at Southern Oaks Rehabilitation in Piedmont, SC.

Betty was born in Fredonia, Kansas on February 22, 1927, to the late Elmer William Dalton and Opal Fyfe Dalton. She grew up attending the First Baptist Church in Fredonia, KS.
