Brenda Mattox Tate, 80, loving wife of Charles Wendell Tate for 57 years, mother, grandmother and friend, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on April 6, 2024, surrounded by her loved ones.

Born and raised in the peach orchards of Greer, South Carolina, she was a graduate of Byrnes High School and North Greenville Junior College. She retired from the Greer Commission of Public Works after serving for 38 years. She was the daughter of the late Nan Chiles Mattox and Manly Murray Mattox and was also predeceased by a sister, Martha Mattox McHugh.

After meeting Charles on a blind date and marrying in 1966, she made Travelers Rest her permanent home, where she was involved in various church and school events, always supporting her children and grandchildren in their various activities.
