



Dr. Charles Stuart Patterson

Dr. Charles Stuart Patterson, 84, husband of the late Anne Earle Patterson, of 105 Hathaway Circle, passed away on Monday, October 27, 2014 at McCall Hospice House.

Born in Greenville County, he was the son of the late Elliot and Ethelyn Long Patterson. Dr. Patterson was a graduate of Easley High School and continued his studies at Furman University where he earned his Bachelor's Degree in chemistry and University of North Carolina where he earned his PhD in Chemistry. Upon graduation from UNC, he returned to Furman University where he taught Chemistry for 34 years, retiring in 1988.

Dr. Patterson was a member of Second Presbyterian Church in Greenville where he served as Deacon and Ruling Elder and was a member of the Frank Outlaw Sunday School Class. He was also a Board Member with the Creation Study Group and on the Board of the Greenville Presbyterian Theological Seminary.

Surviving are his daughters: Sue P. and James M. (Jimbo) Godwin of Bluefield, WV and Jane P. Stillman of Travelers Rest; son: Charles F.
