Chelsea Ursula Hawkins, 19, of 79 Patsy Lane, passed away Sunday, August 24, 2008.

Born in Greenville County, SC, she was a 07' graduate of Travelers Rest High School where she was a 3 sport letterman, in Basketball, Volleyball and Softball. She played on the varsity softball team since the 7th grade. Miss Hawkins was a student at Georgia Perimeter College where she was on a scholarship for softball. She was on the 17 and under softball team the "Crush" that won the World Series, and she played on the "Thundercat" Traveling Softball team thru 07'.

Surviving are her father, Michael T. 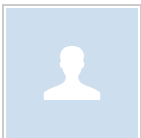
“ Dear Hawkins and Marchbanks Family -
