



Clyde Earnest Anderson

June 16, 1941 - January 27, 2024

Clyde Earnest Anderson (Andy), 82, of Marietta, a proud Veteran of the United States Army, passed away Saturday, January 27, 2024, at Richard M. Campbell Veterans Nursing Home in Anderson, South Carolina.

Born in Kings Mountain, NC, June 16, 1941, he was a son of the late Wilburn Riley and Rixie Paris Anderson, and grew up in Marietta, South Carolina. Mr. Anderson was a retired US Army Veteran and was a member of Shiloh Baptist Church.

At the age of 17, Clyde enlisted in the United States Army. He valued this service highly and attained the rank of E7, SFC. As part of this service, he served during the Vietnam War, Spent 5 ½ years in Italy and 2 years in Germany. He retired June 30, 1978 after 20 years of service.

After retirement Clyde and Myrlene enjoyed traveling in their motor home which included 49 states, all the Provinces in Canada and Mexico. He was a member of the DAV and received the Quilt of Valor as an expression of gratitude for his service on May 3, 2018 in Greenville, South Carolina.

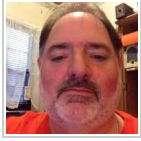
