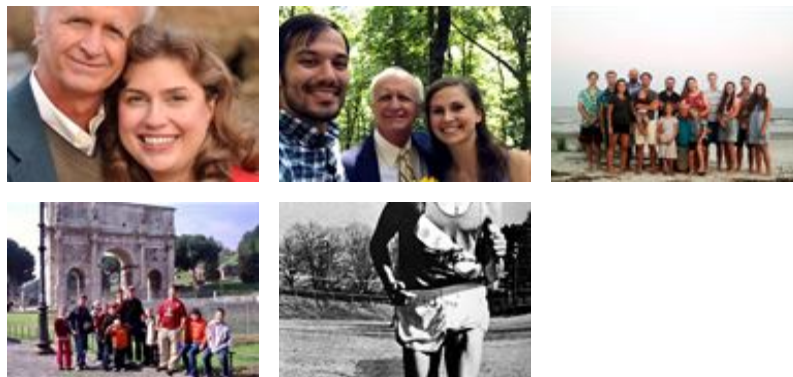


“ *Dear Amy and children,

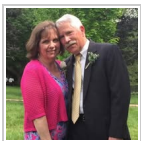
