Donald Maxwell King, 91, formerly of Sanford, Florida and lately of Falls Creek Living Center in Marietta, South Carolina, passed away Wednesday, March 12, 2008. Born in Jackman, Maine, he was the son of the late Mack and Martha King and husband of the late Lillian Catherine Wetherbee King.

Mr. King was a survivor of the Pearl Harbor attack and a fighter pilot serving in Europe during World War II. He retired from the U.S. Air Force and later from the U.S. Postal System. He was an active member of Sanford United Methodist Church, Sanford, Florida.

He was predeceased by a sister, Winifred Russell; a son-in-law, Hugh Golightly; a grandson, Thomas Golightly; and a grand son-in-law, Harry Murphy.
