Elbert Hagood "Shug" Brown, Sr., 85, passed away Saturday, August 9, 2008, at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Born in Pickens County, he was the son of the late Elbert Franklin and Flora Connelly Brown. He was a decorated veteran of the US Army, wounded in WWII and awarded the Purple Heart. Mr. Brown was also retired from the United States Postal Service and a member of Morgan Memorial Baptist Church.

Surviving are his wife of 61 years, Frances Pauline Sims Brown, of the home; son: Elbert Hagood "Ed" Brown, Jr. and his wife Tina; grandsons: James Michael Brown and wife Suzy, Tyler Matthew Lankford, and Evan Daniel Hagood Brown.
