Elmer Roy Tindle, 74, went to be with the Lord on Monday, May 2, 2022, while at home in Easley, SC.

Roy was born in Wichita, KS, on January 6, 1948, to the late Thomas Roy Tindle and the late Betty Jo Dalton Tindle Knight. He grew up in Kansas and joined the U.S. Navy in 1968. After serving in the Navy, Roy moved to Easley, SC where he began his long career as a home builder. Roy built custom homes in the Easley area and will always be remembered for his craftsmanship and perfectionism. Later in his career Roy became a home inspector with Greenville County and Pickens County. An avid fisherman, he spent many hours on the lake with family and friends and participated in Bass Masters. Roy was a member at Rock Springs Baptist Church and attended Tanglewood Baptist Church.

In 2007, Roy suffered a heart attack that left him with a permanent brain injury. Despite this disability, he never lost his strong determined spirit. Roy will be sorely missed and remembered by so many.

He is survived by his loving wife of 21 years, Mary; a son, Steven Roy Tindle; 2 step daughters, Michelle Welter (Wally) and Angie Wagner (John); a sister, Bethany Tindle Colboch (Steve); three brothers, Thomas J.
