The family will have a memorial service at a later date.

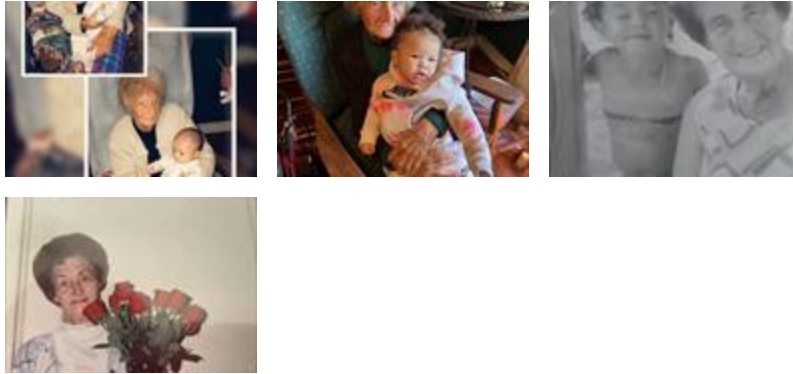
The family will be at their respective homes.
