I knew his diabetes had taken a toll, but was unaware that he had died. My younger brother died earlier this year at age 63. He had a rare and deadly form of liver cancer. Anne, I don't think you ever met him, but I mention his death partly because I seem to recall that your family relocated to Greenville from Knoxville, and Gene and Deborah had eventually settled there. Deborah is on the faculty at UT.

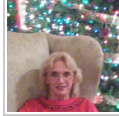
I have many fond memories of the Linder family. And Evelyn remained diligent for years and years about sending a holiday letter. I last saw Evelyn and Pete almost exactly 20 years ago when my mother and I came through Greenville on a Sunday night after having been at Brevard. Found them at Berea First Baptist, and took them out to Capri's for food after church. I recall the time because my mother was 80 then. She would be 100 now if she were alive. Died peacefully at age 95 having lived with Eduardo and me the last several years of her life.

Thank you for your sweet letter. Evelyn thought a lot of you and spoke often of you over the years. Our family has dwindled on one end and increased on the other, as it is in life.

Pete died in 2011, having spent many years in a wheelchair. His last few weeks were at Oakmont Nursing Home in Berea. He was quite grumpy and his size, mobility issues, and weight made it impossible for Evelyn to keep him at home any longer.

Mark passed away in Feb. 2013 ending 57 years of diabetes. He was 63 and I took care of him in our home from 2010-13. I am very grateful that I had that opportunity.

Evelyn was 92 and had struggled with dementia for about 8 years. She retained her sweet, kind ways to the very end and we were able to keep her at home with the assistance of Home Health and then Hospice. She was a blessing to all of us.

Mark and I have two sons. Matthew is 34 and has a girlfriend with 2 children. They live in Lexington, Kentucky but he is itching to get back to Greenville. He works with Charter Cable Co. in customer service and repair.

Jonathan is 33, married to Courtney and has a son, kolton, who is 7 years old. They live in Piedmont, about 45 min. away. Jonathan does IT work for SHARP COPIERS, doing a lot of remote repairs for the school districts in the upstate.

Sorry to learn of your mother's death at 95. A peaceful passing is something to be very grateful for.

I sing in a community chorale, The LEGACY. Choir at Taylor's First Baptist, and Christmas music with Anne Edwards choir and with a small Anglican Church, as well. Also recovering from rotator cuff surgery 7 weeks ago.
