



Faith Toole

October 21, 1948 - May 8, 2018

On May 8, 2018, Faith Garrison Toole passed away after a brief illness at the age of 69 years. Her funeral service will be held Friday at The Howze Mortuary in Travelers Rest at 1:30 pm, with visitation immediately prior at 12:30 pm. Burial will follow at Coleman Memorial Cemetery in Travelers Rest. Faith was born on October 21, 1948 in Shreveport, LA to Lloyd Hudson Garrison and Ruby Graves Garrison. Her fondest memories of her childhood included the times that she spent with her beloved grandfather and trips to visit the Haynes family in Carthage, TX. Faith graduated from Louisiana Tech University with a degree in Early Childhood Education and began her 37 year career. She was National Board certified, and was awarded Teacher of the Year multiple times. She met Allen, her husband of 45 years, while he was stationed at Barksdale Air Force Base. They married in 1972 and decided to make their home in Greenville, SC where Faith, an only child, was warmly welcomed into the large Toole family. Faith's greatest joy was her children and their spouses: Charlotte (Thomas) and Justin (Kathryn). In September 2015, she was ecstatic when she became "Mimi" to Austin Marshall Toole, and she delighted in being able to help care for him for the first few years. Faith was beloved by many family members and friends.

Faith lived her life to the fullest and was such a joyful and positive influence on so many lives. She cherished her time with friends and family, enjoyed traveling and volunteering, and participated in activities such as book club and ADK sorority. She was an active member of Lee Road Baptist Church where

she sang in the choir and taught youth Sunday school.

Faith was a committed supporter of humanitarian and mission work, and she quietly shared her time and resources with many organizations. In lieu of flowers, memorial donations in memory of Faith can be made to World Vision International.
