Frances Ann Beacham Anderson, 94, widow of the late Robert Leon Anderson, passed away Friday, February 6, 2026.

Born and raised in the Camp Creek, North Greenville community, Frances' early life began in a small house on the family farm where she and her sister Martha Lou, started their lifelong bond. She spent her early years watching over her sister, learning to sew her own clothes, and establishing her Christian faith and developed the nurturing, steady presence that would define her life.

Frances met her husband, Bob, at Mountain View High School, beginning a love that would span more than 72 years of marriage. Together, they built a life rooted in love, faith, and adventure - raising their children, collecting memories, and enjoying scenic drives through the community, often across Packs Mountain in one of Bob's antique cars.

While Bob's career took them to many places, from Oklahoma to Puerto Rico, from Canada to Tasmania, North Greenville was always home. Frances embraced the adventure of new places and loved to travel near and far. Among her many adventures, she rode a camel in Jerusalem and snowmobiled in Ontario, Canada. Her time in Jerusalem was especially meaningful and remained a trip she fondly shared with others.

Wherever life took them, Frances embraced her role as homemaker, turning every house into a home. She carried her Southern hospitality with her, introducing neighbors and new friends to her biscuits, sweet tea, and vinegar beans. She loved hosting family and friends around her table, creating a warm and welcoming sanctuary for all.

Later in life, Frances discovered a passion for painting, finding inspiration in nature and landscapes. She had a remarkable ability to envision the finished piece before the first brushstroke touched the canvas. Her many pieces of art capture the natural beauty of the world and local landmarks alike and stand as a lasting testament to her creativity and talent.

Frances was an active and devoted member of Camp Creek Baptist Church throughout her 94 years. She served faithfully in many roles, including the choir, teaching Sunday school, and hosting Bible studies, always supporting her church community in any way she could.

Frances will be remembered for her devotion to her family, her quiet strength, her generosity, and the sense of home she built so easily. Her legacy lives on in the lives she touched, the beauty she created, and the love she shared so faithfully.

Surviving are one son: Robert L. Anderson, Jr. (Ruth); two daughters: Ella Dunlap (Neal) and Nina Lovett; one sister: Martha Waters (Kenneth); five grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.
