November 4, 1944 - November 29, 2025

Fred Allie Dyal, 81, husband of Marilyn McGriff Dyal, of Travelers Rest, SC, died Saturday, November 29, 2025, at his residence after a courageous battle with cancer.

Raised in Ware Shoals, SC, he was one of 10 children born to the late Joseph and Lucy Smith Dyal.

Fred was a retired wastewater treatment plant operator with ReWa for 31 years, where he was a proud promoter of fundraising for the United Way. A true outdoorsman, he enjoyed camping and fishing. Fred was a former commissioner for the North Greenville Fire Department and a Boy Scout leader in Piedmont and Travelers Rest.

Prior to his declining health, he was an active member of Travelers Rest United Methodist Church, where he was a former co-leader (alongside his wife) of the youth group, active member of the United Methodist Men's Group, choir, and even a former janitor. Also, he spent time in his later years helping with the printing of church bulletins and mail outs of the Pew & Pulpit.

Surviving, in addition to his beloved wife of 50 years are two children, James Nathan White and Charlotte Mangum (Preston); granddaughter, Jady Mangum; brother-in-law, Clyde Gilbert (Audrey); sister-in-law and brother-in-
