



## Gary A. Pindroh

March 4, 1942 - January 20, 2024

Gary August Pindroh, 81, completed his earthly life on Saturday, January 20, 2024, and is now rejoicing with the angels in his Heavenly home.

Gary was born on March 4, 1942, in Cleveland, Ohio, and was the son of the late August and Jane Pindroh. He was predeceased by his sister Joyce Span, and is survived by his brother, Thomas Pindroh. Gary graduated from Rhodes High School in 1960 and entered the service of the United States Navy. While in the Navy, his ship participated in rescuing the survivors of the Bay of Pigs incident in Cuba. When he finished his military service, Gary married the love of his life. He and Marlene married in 1962 and remained married until Marlene's passing in February 2018.

Gary and Marlene had three children: Dawn (James) Yearout, the late Kurt (Gina) Pindroh, and Derick (Missie) Pindroh. At the time of his passing, Gary was the grandfather to eight grandchildren: Michael Yearout, Ryan Pindroh, Casee Carter, AJ Pindroh, Nikki Becker, Joshua Pindroh, Elizabeth Yearout, and Rebecca Yearout. He was also the proud great-grandfather of Adalyn, Mason, Anna-Grace, Josiah, Penelope, and Harlow.

Gary was an ordained minister for over 50 years, and served churches in Ohio and South Carolina, and he also ministered as a Hospice Chaplain with Interim Hospice. He fought the good fight, and finished the race set before him, and when he took his last breath here, he opened his eyes to his Heavenly Father telling him, "Well Done, My good and faithful servant."
