Mrs. Glenda Harris Mullinax, 64, wife of Charles Dale Mullinax, died at her home, 109 Hill Top Drive, Travelers Rest, SC, February 19, 2009, after a courageous two year battle with cancer.

She was born June 4, 1944 in Pickens, SC, to the late Eugene and Evie Fortner Harris, and lived most of her adult life in Travelers Rest, SC. She was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother to her family. Mrs. Mullinax was a member of Gap Creek Baptist Church and taught children's Sunday School for over 25 years. 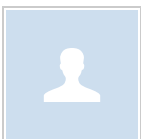
