Glenn Manous, most often referred to by family and friends as “Papa”, and to acquaintances as “the little man with the crooked cap”, left us to be with his Heavenly Father on Tuesday, January 28, 2014.

Glenn, who was raised in a little shack on the side of a mountain in North Carolina, lived to be 88 years of age without a single enemy. He truly possessed the sweetest, gentlest spirit. He was an honest, humble, meek, sweetly simple man, who loved everyone he encountered. He served the Lord faithfully for 46 years. He was a patient, kind, generous, loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather. He was dearly loved by all and had a smile that would light up an entire room. Glenn loved southern gospel music and his family and friends. Even in the last year of his life, after his health began to rapidly decline, Glenn remained loyal to his church. He attended Belvue Baptist Church in Travelers Rest, South Carolina.
