Gregory Lee Norman, 58 formerly of Dover, OH, passed away on Monday, June 9, 2014 at his home in Tampa, FL.

Born May 18, 1956 in Dover, OH, he was the son of the late Robert Earl Norman, Sr. and Margie Lee (Flowers) Davis. He graduated in 1975 from Dover High School and soon thereafter entered the US Air Force where he was stationed at Lowry AFB in Denver, CO where he trained in the aircraft armament modern avionics program. He was employed with several construction firms in Ohio and South Carolina specializing in heavy equipment machine operations and then retired to Florida.

Greg was a Life Scout with the Boy Scouts of America and was a self taught bass guitar player.
