



## Harold Sullivan Hughes

May 5, 1928 - December 20, 2015

Harold Sullivan Hughes, 87, of Greenville, passed away Sunday, December 20, 2015.

Born in Greenville, SC on May 5, 1928, he was a son of the late Lilly and Tom Hughes. Harold grew up in Dunearn Mill Village and Graduated from Parker High School. At age 17 Harold became a United States Marine and served in WWII. He was given an Honorable Discharge from the Marine Corps in 1948, and he returned to Greenville. Soon after his return he married Lucille Ivey Barrett and the two of them celebrated their 60th Wedding Anniversary in November.

Surviving are his wife Lucille Ivey Hughes; two daughters, Susie Hix and Pam Hayes (Roger); three sons, David Barrett (Kay), Terry Barrett (Vi), and Jimmy Hughes (Terri); a daughter-in-law, Debbie Barrett; 16 grandchildren, 8 great grandchildren, 1 great great granddaughter and beloved companion, his dog Ellie Mae.
