



Harold Ray Wilson

December 18, 1928 - December 27, 2017

Harold Wilson, 89, of Marietta, passed away after an extended illness on Wednesday, December 27, 2017, at his home surrounded by his loving family. Born in Mountainaire, NM, he was a son of the late John and Timmie Lee Wood Wilson. He and Marjorie moved here from Fort Campbell Kentucky in 1971, where Ray retired after a military career of twenty-one and a half years. He gained recognition in the Army as part of the Elite US Army Marksmanship Unit and was recognized as one of the top pistol shooters in the world at the time. He was also a faithful member of Gap Creek Baptist Church

Ray is survived by his wife, Marjorie of sixty-seven years and three sons: Harold Ray Wilson Jr. (Colleen) of Bellingham WA, Clifford Wayne Wilson (Susan) of Brooksville, FL, and Paul Neal Wilson of Marietta, SC; one brother: Edker Hamilton Wilson; five grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. Along with his parents he was predeceased by six brothers and three sisters. A Memorial service will be 11:00 a.m. January 13, 2018 at Gap Creek Baptist Church.
