May 12, 1918 - January 20, 2010

Harold M. Forrest, Cdr/US Navy, Ret. 91, formerly of Greenville, died in Clearwater, FL on January 20, 2010, surrounded by his loving family. He was preceded in death by his parents, William M. and Grace V. Forrest and a sister, Elizabeth Belcher. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Gwendol M. Forrest, a son, H.
