



Henry G. Coleman

March 12, 1963 - June 19, 2010

Henry Garfield Coleman, 47, of 3130 Reidville Road, passed away Saturday, June 19, 2010 at his home.

Born in Greenville County, he was a son of Robert M. and Elizabeth "Lib" Bailes Coleman.

Mr. Coleman was a Videographer and after 9-11, he was part of a delegation of officials from Spartanburg County that traveled to New York to present the nearly Three Hundred Thousand dollars raised in Spartanburg County for the victims' families. While in New York Henry along with his camera visited Ground Zero, talked with first responders and even interviewed the last surviving victim pulled from the Twin Towers rubble. On a subsequent trip to New York, the mother of a 9-11 victim presented Henry with an American flag that flew over Ground Zero. This flag is raised every September 11th in a ceremony in the City of Inman to honor those lost that day. Now it can also be raised in memory of Henry. He was also a volunteer Fireman and a member of Enoree Baptist Church.

In addition to his parents he is survived by his wife, Marion McClure Coleman of the home; 2 daughters, Amanda Coleman & Alexis Coleman; 2 step-children, Richard Callihan and Amber Callihan; 2 grandchildren, Lorelai & Ella; a brother, Bobby Coleman and 2 sisters, Deborah C. Batson and Nancy C. Plumblee.

He was predeceased by his grandparents, Joe R. & Ruth M. Coleman and Dr. R.W. and Grace R. Bailes.

A Memorial service will be held at 3 o'clock Friday afternoon at The Howze Mortuary Chapel with burial to follow at Enoree Baptist Church Cemetery.

The family will receive friends from 7 until 8:30 Thursday evening at The Howze Mortuary.

The families will be at the homes of Henry & Marion Coleman and Robert & Lib Coleman.
