Hope Christine Hemingway, age 51, was born on February 2, 1974, in Louisville, Kentucky, to Linda Kay Teuton Hemingway and George M. Hemingway Jr.

Growing up in a military family, Hope moved often, but she embraced each new place with a sense of adventure. Whether snow tubing, hiking, joining a Volksmarch in Germany, skiing in Alaska and Germany, tubing down the Ichetucknee River in Florida, or canoeing in Alabama, Hope found joy in exploring the world around her. But her greatest joy came from being with family and friends—she loved people deeply and wholeheartedly.

Hope was full of life and energy, always eager to participate in a wide variety of activities. A proud and enthusiastic participant in the Special Olympics, she won numerous gold medals over the years in swimming, bowling, gymnastics, and field events. She also had a deep love for music and dancing. She sang in her high school choir and performed solos in talent shows—lighting up the stage with her smile and voice.

Hope graduated from Bartlett High School in Anchorage, Alaska, in 1995. She went on to work through the Tribble Center in Seneca, South Carolina, and worked at Schneider Electric Company, where she contributed with dedication and pride.

Hope had a heart that knew no prejudice. She loved freely and fully, welcoming everyone with open arms and without judgment. She was a huge hugger, and those who knew her always looked forward to her embraces. Her

warmth, joy, and deep acceptance left a lasting impact on everyone she met. To know Hope was to be seen, loved, and valued just as you were. She was a faithful member of Utica Baptist Church in Seneca, South Carolina, where she found great joy in worship and community. Hope is survived by her parents, Linda Kay Teuton Hemingway and George M. Hemingway Jr.; her sister, Paige Hemingway Welch (Michael); brothers, Ged Hemingway (Melinda) and Drew Hemingway (Ashley); and two nephews and five nieces. The family will receive friends Wednesday afternoon from noon until 2:00 p.m. at Utica Baptist Church.

Funeral services will be at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday afternoon at Utica Baptist Church. Burial will follow in Coleman Memorial Cemetery.
