



Hubert Eugene Hunt

Hubert Eugene Hunt., 90, of Travelers Rest, Widower of the late Barbara Lee McCarroll Hunt, passed away Wednesday, August 9, 2023, at his home.

Born in Dacusville, he was a son of the late Joe and Alberta Williams Hunt.

Hubert graduated from Simpson High School in 1949 and served in the US Army from 1953 until 1955. Mr. Hunt served in the Honor Guard for American Legion Post 3, and a member of the Mountain Grove Masonic Lodge #307.

He retired from Fiber Industries in 2001, and was a member of Meadow Fork Baptist Church, where he served as a Deacon, and sang in the all male chorus. Hubert was an excellent cook, known for his cakes and pies, and was the President of the Williams family reunion for over seventeen years.
