



Jack Wayland Sanderson

May 2, 1941 - March 1, 2018

Jack Wayland Sanderson, 76, husband of the late Vivian McKinney Sanderson, went to be with the Lord on Thursday, March 1, 2018 after battling Alzheimer's with courage, dignity and grace.

Born in Dillon County, SC, he was the son of the late Berry and Juanita Johnson Sanderson. Jack graduated from Newberry College and then worked for Liberty Life Insurance Company for 34 years. After retirement from Liberty Life, Jack devoted himself to caring for his wife, Vivian, in her last years, and then to caring for his young grandchildren. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Travelers Rest, where he served as a Deacon. Later in life he attended Downtown Presbyterian Church.

Surviving is his daughter: Bronwen Sanderson Greene and her husband Michael; son: Robert Andrew Sanderson and his wife Jessica Grant Sanderson; brother: Hoyt Sanderson and wife Marion; 4 grandchildren: Elizabeth McKinney Greene, Rachel McCahan Greene, Ian Sanderson Greene and Beau Wayland Sanderson; close relatives: Judy and Pam Bramlett.

Along with his parents, Jack was predeceased by a brother, Pete Sanderson.
