



Jackie Dean "Jack" Anderson

Jackie Dean "Jack" Anderson, 93, of Travelers Rest, passed away Tuesday, January 2, 2018.

Born in Colton, CA, he was the son of the late Henry Sherman and Cora Hargrove Anderson. Mr. Anderson served in the US Navy during WWII, retired from Daniel Construction, and was a member of Enoree Baptist Church. Jack was well known as a baseball player in the South Carolina textile league in the 1940's and 1950's.

Surviving are his wife of seventy-one years, Mary Azalee Mathis Anderson; three sons: Jack Edward Anderson (Angela), Tony Dean Anderson (Sandra), and James Marvin Anderson (Jan); three brothers: Robert L.
