



## James Reginald "Reggie" O'Dell

James Reginald "Reggie" O'Dell, 86, husband of the late Patricia "Pat" Bridgeman O'Dell, passed away on Monday, October 28, 2024, at his home.

Born in Greer, SC, Reggie was the son of the late James Meggs O'Dell and Eula Corn O'Dell. He was a graduate of the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science after which he assisted his father in operating the former O'Dell Mortuary here in Travelers Rest which is now The Howze Mortuary.
