Born in Greenville County he was a son of the late Ansel B. and Bonnie Hopson McMakin. Mr. McMakin was retired as Slater-Marietta Fire Chief after 40 years of service. He was a WWII Army Veteran and a member of Slater Baptist Church where he formerly served as deacon. He was a member of the Slater Lions Club and was Past President of the Fire Chiefs Association.
