August 10, 1950 - August 6, 2018

Janice “Jan” Gutshall Deuerling, 67, of Travelers Rest, passed away at Lancaster General Hospital in Lancaster, Pennsylvania on Monday, August the 6th after suffering a hemorrhagic stroke on July 23 while on vacation.

Daughter of the late George and Mildred Vickery Gutshall, Janice is survived by her husband of 45 years David; her sons James, Zachary, and Jonah; her grandsons Jeremiah and Elijah; and her brother George Carlton Gutshall of Travelers Rest and sister Sue Hendricks of Greenville.

Mrs. Deuerling was a 1969 graduate of Blue Ridge High School. She would marry David in 1973 at Lima Baptist Church in Travelers Rest. She would go on to hold several different positions but was most noted for her role as a stay-at-home mother of her three sons and two grandsons. She is remembered as a devoted wife and mother, who was passionate about her faith, cared for others in need, and enjoyed the theater, nature, and animals. Janice was a proud survivor of cancer and committed annual efforts to multiple Relay for Life events held across Greenville.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, August the 18th at 2:00 pm in the Chapel of Howze Mortuary, 6714 State Park Road, Travelers Rest.
