



John Anthony (Tony) Bishop

February 29, 1940 - July 26, 2025

John Anthony (Tony) Bishop of Greenville, SC, passed away at home on July 26, 2025 at the age of 85.

Born in Greenville on February 29, 1940 to John Vollie and Mae Tankersley Bishop, John graduated from Travelers Rest High School where he was on the varsity football and track teams. He served his country in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Canisteo, and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology from Furman University. After working for the Southeastern Cooperative Wildlife Disease Studies at the University of Georgia, he returned to Greenville to work in the textile industry. Later in life he opened his own businesses in cabinetry and birding supplies; in retirement years he enjoyed working in the garden department at Home Depot.

A lifelong outdoorsman, birder, and hunter, he became a scoutmaster who taught many young men to love and respect nature. He was a founding member of the Travelers Rest Historical Society and a longtime member of Trinity Presbyterian Church, where he served as a ruling elder and Sunday school teacher.

John was a loving husband, father and grandfather, and a loyal friend. He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Dorothy Neal Bishop, his children Betsy (Ken) Weiss and Andrew (Julea Summers) Bishop, and his grandchildren Andrea, Ashley, Maegan and Katherine.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, August 1st, 2025 at 1PM, at Trinity Presbyterian Church in Travelers Rest.

The family will receive friends following the service.
