John Hubert Dunn, Jr., 86, of Marietta, passed away Sunday, March 1, 2015 at St. Francis Hospital.

Born in Jonesborough, TN, on July 23, 1928, he was a son of the late John Hubert Dunn, Sr. and Bonnie Laws Dunn. "Mr. John" owned and operated Dunn Grading since the late 70's.
