John Charles Hatfield, 64, of 866 Hunter Rd., died at his home Tuesday, June 3, 2008, after a short illness.

Born in Alexander, Maine on Sept. 25, 1943, he was the son of the late Cecil Arthur and Edith Keene Hatfield. After serving in the 173rd Airborne Battalion, Mr. Hatfield married his high school sweetheart, Sharon Ivey, of Sherman Station, Maine on July 3, 1965. After earning a Master's Degree in Divinity from Tennessee Temple University, he preached for 6 years. He later started his own garage construction business, which he ran for 30 years, and built three of his own houses.
