TSGT John William Sammons, 85, husband of Mary Willis Sammons for 61 years, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Anderson, SC, he was the son of the late Lloyd Elmer Sammons and Pallie Gafford Sammons. A graduate of Anderson High School, John went on and honorably served his country in the U.S. Air Force, retiring in March of 1976 after 24 years of dedicated service.
