Judy Neves Styles Holloway, 75, of Travelers Rest, passed away on Sunday, March 29th, 2020 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Styles Holloway is survived by two sons: Ben Styles (Julie) and Chris Styles (Angie); one daughter: Valeria Styles McAlister; thirteen grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

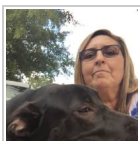

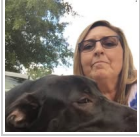
