Julius Furman "Bill" Hall, of the Locust Hill Community, passed away Saturday, December 6, 2008 at St. Francis Hospital.

Born in Walhalla, SC, he was the son of the late Robert L. and Mae Adams Hall. In the sixties, he was one of the pioneers in conservation of energy in the home with his patented vent cover, which was marketed through Sears and K-Mart throughout the southeast. Bill retired from Sacco Lowell and General Electric; served in the Navy in the South Pacific during World War II and was a member of Locust Hill Baptist Church.
