Kenneth Lawrence (Ken) Beck, 84, of Greenville, passed away in his home Saturday, December 25, 2021.

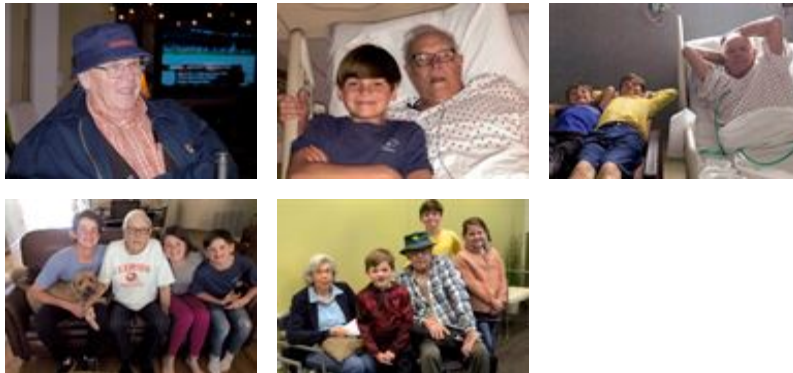
