Kenneth Harold Cisson 77, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, January 16, 2018 at St. Francis Hospital in Greenville.

Born in Pickens County, he was the son of the late Vernon and Effie Ledford Cisson. Kenneth was a self employed building contractor, a member of Ebenezer Lodge #101, A.F.M. in Marietta and a member of Pleasant Grove Baptist Church in Pumpkintown. He loved blue grass music and played with the Heartstrings Blue Grass Band as their bass player.
