March 2, 1964 - February 20, 2020

Laurie Jane (Cherkas) Niederhelmann, age 55, of Greenville, departed from this world unexpectedly on February 20, 2020.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA, she was daughter of the late Harry Frazier Sr. and MaryAnn (Chapman) Cherkas. She was also predeceased by her brother, Derrick Cherkas, of Cleveland, SC and her in-laws Wilhelm and Frieda Niederhelmann of Hördinghausen, Germany.

Laurie was a professional dancer, having been a member of the Atlanta Jazz Company and Deutsche Meisterschaft. Laurie also taught and choreographed for competitive students and competed in dance in the World Cup for Germany.

Survivors include her son Harrison Frazier Niederhelmann of Lintorf, Germany; her brother Harry Frazier Cherkas Jr. of Cleveland, SC; her longtime companion Larry Shadoan of Greenville, SC; Wilfried Niederhelmann, son's father of Lintorf, Germany.

A Memorial Service will be held Friday, February 28, 2020 at 2:00pm at The Howze Mortuary Chapel.

remembered for her kind and caring spirit, her infectious laughter and her love for storytelling. Laurie's energy and enthusiasm could light up a room. She was encouraging, optimistic and went out of her way to make people feel special.
