Loretta Daniel Beacham, devoted wife, mother, Nana and friend, whose life was rooted in love, faith, and her family, went to be with her Heavenly Father on December 21, 2025.

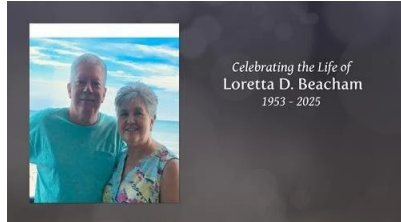
