“ Some have asked about how I was doing. My response is that I have HOPE in that I will see my brother again. Mark realized as a young boy that he had done wrong things: we call it “sin”, and it’s inherent in all mankind. Even as a boy, he realized that there was nothing he could ever do to merit getting to heaven on his own, and he accepted the free gift of eternal life by asking Jesus Christ to be the Lord of his life and take away his debt of sin. As our understanding grew as we got older, we also realized that all who refuse that gift will never get to heaven (Christ’s words, not mine: “I am the (only) way, the truth, the life. No man cometh unto the Father but by me.”). Christ told one story of the rich man and Lazarus and the consequences for rejecting Him. No second chances—the choices we make here have eternal consequences. The good news? “God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.” And of course, John 3:16: “For God so loved the world (body of mankind) that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” One day we will stand before Him to give an account of our lives. He will either be our Judge or our Savior. The choice is ours alone to make. Hebrews 9:27 tells us: “And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:”. Finally Jesus himself makes it very clear in Matthew 25:46 there are only two choices: “And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.”
