Martha Louise "Marti" Bannon, 82, of Marietta, devoted wife, mother, and "Grandma," passed away Saturday, April 4, 2026, at her residence, with her loving family by her side.

Born in Colton, New York, on June 28, 1943, she was the daughter of the late Ralph and Hilda Wells Moses.

Marti, a United States Air Force veteran, met her future husband during her service. Throughout her life, in each of her various roles, she approached her work as an opportunity to serve others. She spent many years as a hairstylist and went on to work in the accounting department at Walt Disney World, where she retired.
